

## T. 15 N., R. 41 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within T. 15 N., R. 41 E., varies from nearly level terrain in the west and central portions to gently rolling in the east portion. The elevations range from about 6,300 ft. to 6,400 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky sandy loam on the edges of the bottom land to black loam in the bottom lands. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, pasture grass, and other native grasses. There are scattered stands of willows along the Reese River which flows through the township in a northerly direction.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

The average of a number of readings along the lines surveyed and resurveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of  $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E. with a range of  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  in local attraction.
