

	S. 89° 33' W., bet. secs. 10 and 15.
	Through a residential area.
19.80	Elko Road, asphalt, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S. to intersection with Sixth Street.
19.93	Point for the W. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 15.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in a collar of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

	Continue over nearly level ground.
20.536	Point for Cor. No. 4 of the Indenture dated April 22, 1931,
	between Charlotte M. and John E. Worden and the United States of America, recorded in Book 46, Page 56, of the Elko County records. Point is also described in the Indenture dated June 27, 1923 between the Wordens and the City and County of Elko for a road right-of-way, recorded in Book 71, Page 545, as being 40 ft. W. of the W. 1/16 sec. cor.
	Set a 20 penny nail, flush with the surface of an asphalt road, Sixth Street, marked X on head of the nail.

	A spike in a powerpole, bears N. 89° 55' W., 65 lks. dist.
20.60	Sixth Street, asphalt, 60 lks. wide, bears S. 45° E. and N. 45° W.
27.89	Point for Cor. No. 5 of the Indenture dated April 22, 1931,
	between John E. and Charlotte M. Worden and the United States of America, recorded in Book 46, Page 56, of the Elko County records. Corner's position is on the northerly right-of-way of Fifth Street.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in a collar of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
	
	This cor. is located in a drainage ditch, 10 lks. wide, drains S.
29.00	Fifth Street, asphalt, 60 lks. wide, bears S. 48° E. and N. 48° W.
29.40	Entrance road to Willows Apartments from Fifth Street, 30 lks. wide, bears S. 48° W.
30.40	Cor. No. 2 of the Warranty Deed dated February 18, 1930, between John E. and Charlotte M. Worden and the United States of America, recorded in Book 45, Pages 519 and 520, of the Elko County records. Corner's position is on the southerly right-of-way of Fifth Street, and is monumented
