T. 46 N., R. 54 E., MDM, NEVADA

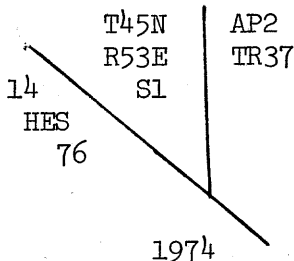

Fence and powerline, bear SSE. and NNW.; enter rolling mountains.

18.14

Point for Cor. 14, H.E.S. 76, identical with Angle Point No. 2, Tract 37, at proportionate distance. The original monument, a granite stone, broken in pieces, one piece 6x5x4 ins., mkd. 14 H.E.S. on one face, lying loose on the ground near this point.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post alongside the iron post, and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

Highway No. 51, bears N. 33° W. and S. 33° E.; asc. 310 ft. over SW. slope.

The standard cor. of T. 46 N., R. 53 E., identical with Angle Point No. 1, Tract 37, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, with brass cap mkd.
