CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 33 North, Range 32 East, ranges from about 4,100 to 5,100 ft. above sea level and is nearly level to rolling. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, rabbitbrush and shadscale.

The township is drained by minor dry washes which winds southeasterly through the township. Abel Spring is located in section 20, and the south one half of section 36, is in Rye Patch Reservoir.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous desert and trail roads.
