Reestablishment of the Survey of the Dyer's  
Seventh Standard Parallel North,  
Executed by E. H. Dyer, U. S. Deputy Surveyor,  
in 1863.

The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with  
an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed  
6 ins. above ground, with steel fence post alongside,  
with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of  
T. 32 N., R. 32 E., executed concurrently under Group  
No. 498.

S. 89° 17' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35.

Over nearly level land, through budsage, shadscale and  
greasewood.

8.70 Trail road, bears N. and S.

39.60 The standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 35, monumented with a  
wooden post, 1x1x20 ins. long, loosely set in a mound  
of earth. No scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

41.37 The standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with  
the remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of  
earth. No scribe marks visible.
