

TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 32 North, Range 32 East, ranges from about 4,150 to 5,400 ft. above sea level and is nearly level to rolling. The soil consists of sandy clay in the lower elevations and gravelly and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of bud-sage, shadscale and greasewood.

The township is drained by washes which flow in a general east direction into Rye Patch Reservoir, which flows in a southerly direction and is located on the eastern portion of the township.

A cabin is located in section 18 and a well is located in section 22.

The principal use of this area is for livestock grazing, camping, boating and fishing. Access into the township is provided by an improved road and numerous trail roads. There has been mining activity in the western portion of the township.
