The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the Forsyth 1973 resurvey, from which Forsyth's bearing trees

A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 62° E., 23 lks. dist., with scribe marks $\frac{1}{4}$ S27 BT visible on open blaze.

A juniper, 3 ins. diam., bears N. 16° W., 29 lks. dist., with scribe marks X BT visible on open blaze.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the Forsyth 1973 resurvey, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A pinon stump, 12 ins. diam., bears S. $74\frac{1}{4}^\circ$ E., 45 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on a decayed blaze. (Record, S. 47° E., 40 lks. dist.)

A pinon, 12 ins. diam., bears S. $26\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., 30 lks. dist., mkd. with healed blaze. (Record, S. 29° W., 75 lks. dist.)

and Forsyth's bearing trees

A pinon, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 58° E., 47 lks. dist., mkd. with a healed blaze.

A pinon, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $72\frac{1}{4}^\circ$ E., 22 lks. dist., with scribe marks X BT visible on open blaze.

A pinon, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 100 lks. dist., with scribe marks T12N R21E S32 BT visible on open blaze.

N. $3^\circ 00'$ W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Asc. across broken W. slope, through scattering pinon, juniper, and sagebrush.

22.20 Jeep road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 33° E. and S. 33° W.

41.36 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
