15.50	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 54° E. and S. 54° W.
40.59	The center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 4.
55.10	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears North and South.
62.80	Dry creek bed, 5 lks. wide, drains South; asc. along gentle E. slope.
