Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
Preble and Thorburn, U. S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1881.

From the cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E.,
monumented with a limestone, 28x16x8 ins., firmly set
in a deeply embedded mound of stone and exposed 6 ins.
above ground, plainly mkd. with 6 grooves on N., S.,
E. and W. faces. This corner now refers to the cor.
of Tps. 26 and 27 N., R. 67 E., only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
