CHAINS

- 29.70 Summit of Kingsley Mountains, bears NNE. and SSW.;
desc. 300 ft. over W. slope.
- 40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, north 2 lks.
from the secant.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,
4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
- $$\begin{array}{r} T27N R68E \\ S 31 \\ \frac{1}{4} \frac{S 31}{S 6} \\ T26N \\ 1974 \end{array}$$
- Descend 150 ft. over W. slope.
- 46.90 Ravine, drains NW.; asc. 40 ft. over E. slope.
- 48.10 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 380 ft. over NW. slope.
- 81.18 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 26 N., R. 67 E.
- Point for the closing corner of Tps. 26 and 27 N.,
R. 68 E., north 4 lks. from the secant.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins.
in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap,
4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
