	<p>Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N., R. 67 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 67 E., surveyed concurrently under this same group.</p> <p>N. 1° 13' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 36.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through scattered undergrowth.</p> <p>32.83 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 28 N., R. 68 E., herein- after described.</p> <p>40.20 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at propor- tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
