	<div>INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY, T. 28 N., R. 68 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA</div> <div>This Independent Resurvey Supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881. A diligent search was made for the original corners and those found are described in the following notes.</div> <div>From the cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 28 N., R. 69 E., surveyed under Group No. 463.</div> <div>WEST, with the establishment of the boundary bet. Tps. 28 and 29 N., R. 68 E., bet. secs. 1 and 36, on a transit line describing the secant, which starts from a point 4 lks. South of the Tp. cor., and bears N. 89° 57.8' W.</div> <div>Over mountainous land, through medium timber and undergrowth; asc. 180 ft. along S. slope changing to E. slope.</div> <div>16.50<div>Spur, slopes S.; desc. 280 ft. over broken NW. slope.</div></div> <div>38.00<div>Draw, drains N.; asc. 20 ft. over E. slope.</div></div> <div>40.00<div>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, North 2 lks. from the secant.</div><div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to cap, with brass cap mkd.</div><div><div>T29N R68E</div><div>¼ <div>S 36</div><div>S 1</div></div><div>T28N</div><div>1975</div></div><div>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</div><div>Ascend slightly over E. slope.</div></div> <div>41.50<div>Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 110 ft. over WSW. slope.</div></div> <div>49.70<div>Draw, drains NW.; enter gently rolling land, covered with scattered timber and undergrowth; desc. 150 ft. over gradual NW. slope.</div></div> <div>80.00<div>Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the secant.</div><div>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</div></div>
