	<p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T29N R68E</div><div>S 31 S 32</div><div>S 6 S 5</div><div>T28N</div></div> <p>1975</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, monumented with a wooden post, 25 ins. long, 2 ins. square, with illegible scribe marks visible, firmly set alongside a steel fence post, bears N. 16° 27' E., 14.81 chs. dist. Add the marks AM and bury the wooden post 6 ins. below the surface of the ground.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, sandy clay. Undergrowth, sagebrush, whitesage and shadscale.</p> <hr/>
40.00	<p>WEST, bet. secs. 6 and 31, on a transit line describing the secant, which bears S. 89° 58.5' W.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, North 2 lks. from the secant.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T29N R68E</div><div>S 31</div><div>¼ — S 6</div><div>T28N</div></div> <p>1975</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, N. of cor.</p>
