	<p style="text-align: center;">T20N R26E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 S 1 1974</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>This corner is located in a draw draining SSE.; asc. 240 ft. over S. slope changing to W. slope.</p> <p>87.87 The closing corner of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with a basalt stone, 12x12x8 ins., firmly set 6 ins. in the ground, mkd. with CC on S. face, 1 groove on E. face and 5 grooves on W. face.</p> <p>Mark the original cornerstone with the letters AM for amended monument and bury.</p>	
	<p>88.38 Intersect the Fourth Standard Parallel North.</p> <p>Point for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T21N R26E <u>S 35</u> S 2 S 1 C C T20N R26E 1974</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, bears N. $89^{\circ} 58'$ E., 13.36 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field note record of the dependent resurvey of T. 21 N., R. 26 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.</p>
