DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 21 N., R. 26 E., MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The land within Township 21 North, Range 26 East, ranges from about 4,000 to 5,500 ft. above sea level and is mountainous in the east portion to rolling and nearly level in the west portion. The township is drained by numerous ravines and washes draining generally west. There is a large sink located in the west portion of the township. The soil varies from blow sand and rock in the higher elevations to sandy clay loam in the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of greasewood and shadscale. Interstate 80 crosses through the northwest corner of the township, from the west boundary of sec. 18, northeast to the north boundary of sec. 5. Further acess to the township is provided by numerous desert trail roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
