GENERAL DESCRIPTION Brady Hot Springs is situated in the NE. corner of Township 22 North, Range 26 East. The area varies from mountainous in the west portion to nearly level in NE. and SE. portions with the remaining terrain being gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 4,000 to 5,900 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and very rocky in the higher elevations to alkali on the bottom lands. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush and junegrass or locally called cheatgrass. Interstate 80 crosses the township from SW. to NE. Further access into the township is provided by numerous secondary and desert trail roads. A radio station is situated in the north central part of sec. 15, and there are numerous foundations located in sec. 12. No mineral formations of any consequences were noted; however, several geothermal hot springs and wells are located in the NE. portion of the township.
