From the cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N., Rs. 27 and 28 E.

S. 89° 11' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over nearly level desert land, covered with shadscale
and greasewood.

25.20 Trail road, parallels powerline.

25.50 Powerline, bears S. 27½° W. and N. 27½° E.

40.06 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with an
iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 20 ins.
above ground, with brass cap mkd.
