The land is level and nearly level to rolling in the northwest corner of the Township. The soil is a sandy clay loam to rocky in the northwest portion. Vegetation consists of shadscale and greasewood.</p> <p>There is a powerline entering the township in section 32 and exiting in section 1. Southern Pacific Railroad enters the township in section 35, exiting in section 36.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous trail roads. There has been mining activity in the northwest portion of the township.</p>
