This is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T41N R42E R43E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7</p> </div> <p>1974</p> <p>reset the cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground alongside the iron post.</p>
