	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land within Township 41 North, Range 42 East, ranges from about 4,600 to 5,000 ft. above sea level and is gently rolling to rolling. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush, shadscale and native bunchgrass.</p> <p>The North Fork Little Humboldt River and the South Fork Little Humboldt River join and comprise the Little Humboldt River which flows westerly through the southern portion of the Tp. An earth filled dam is under construction on the Little Humboldt River in sec. 36.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous desert and trail roads throughout the township.</p>
