

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES
T. 37 N., R. 56 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 37 North, Range 56 East, varies from rolling to mountainous in the north-west portion. The elevation ranges from 5,600 to 8,100 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from a sandy clay loam to rocky in the northwest portion. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and sparse native grasses.

Coal Mine Canyon Creek enters the township in section 3 flowing in a southeasterly direction and leaving the township in section 13.

There are numerous trail roads throughout the township.

There were no mineral formations noted in the area.
