40.19	<p>N. 0° 21' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with sagebrush.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div>T36N R57E R58E ¼ S 1 S 6</div> <p>1975</p> <p>set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, 16 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>
80.38	<p>The cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., monumented with the remains of a willow post, 1x1 ins., 12 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div>T37N R57E R58E S 36 S 37 S 1 S 6 T36N</div> <p>1977</p> <p>The markings on the brass cap are in accordance with the Supplemental Special Instructions dated July 1, 1977 for Group No. 537.</p> <p>reset the original wooden post and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>
