GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 36 North, Range 57 East, ranges from about 5,200 to 6,100 ft. above sea level and varies from rolling in the northeastern portion to nearly level in the central portion with the remaining terrain being gently rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay loam on the higher elevations to sandy loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and rabbitbrush.

The eastern portion of the township is drained by the North Fork of the Humboldt River flowing south and the western portion of the township is drained by Coal Mine Creek flowing south. There are wells in sections 8, 14 and 19. There are houses located in sections 23 and 28.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
