		GENERAL DESCRIPTION
		The area resurveyed within Township 37 North, Range 57 East, varies from 5300 to 6300 ft. above sea level and varies from rolling land in the eastern portion to nearly level in the central portion with the remaining land being gently rolling land. The soil varies from sandy clay and rocky on the higher elevations to sandy

loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and willows.

The eastern portion of the Township is drained by the North Fork of the Humboldt River flowing SSW. and the western portion of the Township is drained by Coal Mine Creek flowing SSE. There is a windmill in section 10. There are houses located in sections 9, 17, 19 and 21.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the Township is provided by improved and unimproved roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
