DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 34 N., R. 63 E., MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The area resurveyed within Township 34 North, Range 63 East, varies from mountainous in the SE. portion and a small portion of secs. 4 and 5 have a ridge with the remaining terrain nearly level. The elevation ranges from about 5,580 to 6,080 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from a rocky clay loam on the higher elevations to alkalai clay on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush and greasewood. There are scattered stands of pinon and juniper trees in the higher elevations. The Western Pacific Railroad crosses the NE. corner of the township. A slough and Steele Creek drains the area from the NW. cor. of the township to the east central portion of the township. Point Springs is situated in sec. 35.
