The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 6,700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from alkali in the east portion changing gradually to sandy loam and rocky in the higher elevations of the west portion.</p> <p>The vegetation consists of shadscale, meadowgrass, sagebrush, greasewood, juniper and pinon.</p> <p>Springs are located in secs. 17, 29 and 32.</p>
