	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 34 North, Range 65 East is nearly level with a few sandy mounds scattered throughout. The average elevation is about 5,600 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from a clay to sandy loam, both containing a little alkali. The vegetation consists mainly of greasewood and shadscale.</p> <p>The principal use of the township is grazing for livestock.</p> <p>No mineral formations were noted during the survey.</p>
