The elevation ranges from about 5,200 to 5,900 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from a sandy loam in the bottom land to rocky in the rolling areas. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, crested wheatgrass and juniper in the higher elevations.</p> <p>Goose Creek enters the township in sec. 19, flowing in a northeasterly direction, and leaving in sec. 1. Trout Creek Ranch is located in sec. 2.</p> <p>There are numerous trail roads throughout the township.</p> <p>There were no mineral formations noted in the area.</p>
