	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 10 North, Range 44 East, varies from gently rolling in the north portion to mountainous in the south portions of secs. 19 and 20. The elevation ranges from about 5,900 to 6,900 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy gravel in the lower elevations to shale rock in the mountains. The vegetation consists of shadscale and sagebrush. The township drains in a NW. direction.</p> <p>The town of Round Mountain, Nevada, is located in sec. 20. At the time of this survey there is considerable mining activity in the south portions of secs. 19 and 20. Other users of the Township are cattlemen.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by Nevada State Highway No. 92, and supplemented by other improved and unimproved trail roads.</p>
