62.00	Asc. over SE. slope and enter timber, edge bears E. and W. Spur, slopes ESE.; desc. over NE. slope.
76.00	Bottom of descent; asc. over SE. slope.
80.22	The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, monumented with a granite stone, 16 x 10 x 6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 6 ins. high, mkd. with 3 notches on the S. face and 2 notches partially visible on the N. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. <div>T 12 N R 37 E R 38 E S 13 S 18 S 24 S 19 1976</div> Bury the mkd. stone alongside the iron post.

39.68	The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, monumented with a granite stone, 24 x 18 x 4 ins., loosely set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, mkd. with illegible marks on S. face, from which the original bearing tree A downed pinon pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 63½° E., 67 lks. dist., mkd. S XVIII BT. (Record, N. 60° E., 68 lks. dist.) At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. <div>T 12 N R 37 E R 38 E ¼ S 13 S 18 1976</div> Bury the mkd. stone in the mound of stone.
