	<p>From this point the cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 40 and 41 E., bears S. 89° 42' E., 236.20 chs. dist., monumented with a granite stone, 34 x 30 x 20 ins., firmly set, protruding 10 ins. above the ground, in a scattered mound of stone, mkd. with 5 grooves on N. and 3 grooves on E. faces; there are no other visible marks.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone, 4½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T 12 N R 40 E R 41 E S 36 S 31 S 1 S 6 T 11 N 1976</div></div> <p>Bury the original stone and an iron horseshoe alongside the iron post in the mound of stone.</p> <p>This control line was fully retraced and careful search was made for evidence of intervening corners, none of which was recovered.</p> <p>N. 89° 42' W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.</p> <p>Asc. over NE. slope, through moderate juniper, pinon pine, and sagebrush.</p>
2.80	Top of ascent; thence over nearly level land.
19.685	<p>Point for the E. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>E 1/16 S 33 S 4 1976</div></div>
39.37	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T 12 N R 40 E S 33 ¼ S 4 T 11 N 1976</div></div> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.</p>
50.30	Leave nearly level land; desc. over W. slope.
63.75	Indian Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 50° E.; thence over nearly level land.
73.90	Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.; thence over rolling hills.
