	Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W. of cor. Cor. is located in cultivated field.	
40.70	Leave cultivated field, edge bears S. 40° E. and N. 40° W.	
41.40	Clear Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 40° W.	
60.735	Point for the N. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.	
	<p>N 1/16 S 26 S 25 1975</p>	
	Raise a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.	
68.50	Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 60° E. and N. 60° W.	
80.98	The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, monumented with a granite stone, 16 x 5 x 3 ins., firmly set, protruding 12 ins. above the ground, mkd. with 2 grooves on the S. and 1 groove on the E. faces. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.	
	<p>T 13 N R 40 E S 23 S 24 S 26 S 25 1975</p>	
	Bury the stone alongside and raise a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.	
	From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the W. bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 41 E., executed concurrently under this same group. N. 86° 57' W., bet. secs. 24 and 25. Over nearly level land, through moderate sagebrush.	
38.97	Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor. Set an iron post 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
