	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The land encompassed in this survey is in the same township with the Reese River Forest Service District Ranger Station in Nye County, Nevada. Access is by way of several unimproved dirt roads extending easterly off of State Hwy. 21, also a dirt road.
	The area drains northwesterly into the Reese River. Clear Creek, a main tributary, drains northwesterly through the area into the Reese River. The elevation ranges from about 7000 feet above sea level to about 6500 feet above sea level.
	The soil is composed mainly of sandy loam. The vegetation consists mainly of a moderate growth of sage- brush and native grasses.
