## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land encompassed in this survey is located approximately 4 miles east of the Reese River Forest Service District Ranger Station in Nye County, Nevada. Access is by way of several unimproved dirt roads extending easterly from the vicinity of the Range Station.

The elevation ranges from about 7500 ft. above sea level in the eastern portion of section 32, to about 7000 ft. above sea level in the western portions of sections 30 and 31.

The soil is composed mainly of sandy loam and rock. Clear Creek, a main tributary, drains northwesterly through sections 31 and 32, towards the Reese River. The vegetation consists mainly of scattering to light stands of juniper and pinon with a moderate undergrowth of sagebrush.

At the time of the survey no mining explorations were in progress. The only improvements noted in the area were several small Indian ranch houses.

The average of a considerable number of readings throughout the area gives a value of  $17^{\circ}$  E. for the mean magnetic declination.
