GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 12 North, Range 61 East, varies from rolling in the west portion and gently rolling to nearly level in the east portion. The elevation ranges from about 5,500 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay and rocky on the higher elevations to sandy clay and gravelly on the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of juniper, pinon and sagebrush in the higher elevations, and sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood in thee lower elevations.

The town of Preston is situated in the SE. portion of sec. 12. Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by State Route No. 38 which crosses through the NE. portion of sec. 1, and by numerous trail roads throughout the township.

There were no mineral formations of consequence noted during the survey.
