<p>CHAINS 34.00  37.84</p>	<p>Draw, drains NE.; asc. 100 ft. over an E. slope.</p> <p>The cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 S., Rs. 50 and 51 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 50 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.</p>
	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land resurveyed along the boundaries varies from rolling and sandy clay loam to mountainous and rocky in the west 2 miles of the N. bdy. The elevation ranges from about 6,000 to 8,000 ft. above sea level. The timber consists of juniper and pinon in the mountainous part, and the vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grasses in the rolling part.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are people in the cattle industry and the U.S. Air Force. Access is provided by trail roads in the southern half of the E. bdy.</p> <p>No mineral activity was noted.</p>
