	<p>From this same corner, the SW. cor. of sec. 7, T. 35 N., R. 65 E., as resurveyed by Potter, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 35 N., R. 65 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group, bears N. 89° 35' W., 25.50 chs. dist.</p> <p>Thence N. 0° 53' E., across sec. 7, T. 35 N., R. 65 E., continuing measurement.</p> <p>41.40 Point for the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. NOT MONUMENTED.</p> <p>42.50 Trail road, bears S. 80° E. and N. 80° W.</p> <p>82.80 The cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with decayed remains of a wooden post in small pieces, no marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth. This corner now refers to sec. 1 only.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T35N R64E S 1</div><div>R65E S 7</div></div> <p>1976</p> <p>deposit the remains of the original wooden post alongside the aluminum post and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 2 ft. high, NW. of cor.</p>
