| 80.32 | <p>The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with a squared wooden post, 2 x 2 x 36 ins., with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, and in mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> T35N R63E R64E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7 </div> <p>1976</p> <p>deposit the original wooden post alongside the aluminum post.</p> |
