N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush.

- 6.90 Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.
11.90 Trail road, bears ESE. and WNW.
19.90 Fence, bears ESE. and WNW.
40.03 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with the remains of a squared willow post, 10 ins. long, 1 in. square, firmly set in a circle of stone and exposed 8 ins. above ground, with illegible scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
