	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land within Township 29 North, Range 64 East, ranges from about 6000 to 6500 ft. above sea level, and is situated about 6 miles NNW. of Currie, Nevada. The land is nearly level to rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay to gravel and rocky.</p> <p>The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grasses, there are scattered juniper and pinon along the west boundary.</p> <p>The Nevada Northern Railroad crosses NE. through section 36. U. S. Highway No. 93 crosses NNW. through sections 31, 30 and 19.</p> <p>The Phalen Creek Ranch is located in sections 31 and 32. There is a water well with storage tanks in section 15.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>There are numerous desert and trail roads throughout the township.</p>
