58.50	E. bound lane of Interstate Highway No. 80, asphalt, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 55° W. and S. 51° E., in a curve.
61.00	Fence, barbed wire, 4 strand, bears N. 51° W. and S. 51° E.
63.27	Intersect the southwesterly right-of-way of Interstate Highway No. 80, a fence, 3 strand barbed and woven wire, bears S. 44° E. and N. 44° W.

22.80	Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 63° E. and S. 63° W.
37.14	Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 55° W. and S. 55° E.
40.08	Point for the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 12, at intersection with the E. and W. center line of sec. 12.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
