27.50	Angle Point on the southwesterly right-of-way, a hub and tack, identified as station "Oe" 219+11.96 P.O.T./"Be" 219+11.96 P.C., located in the fence. <hr/>
	N. 44° 12' W.
	Along a wire mesh fence, 4½ ft. high.
0.40	The intersection point on the E. and W. center line of sec. 12, and the southwesterly right-of-way, hereinbefore described. From this point the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 12 bears S. 89° 59' W., 16.66 chs. dist., hereinbefore described. <hr/>
	N. 44° 12' W.
	Along a wire mesh fence, 4½ ft. high.
23.81	Intersect the N. and S. center line of sec. 12.
55.86	The intersection point on the line bet. secs. 1 and 12 and the southwesterly right-of-way, hereinbefore described. From this point the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12, bears N. 89° 59' W., 18.44 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.
GENERAL DESCRIPTION
