	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed and surveyed is situated approximately four miles north of Ruby Lake National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters. The soil is sandy loam. The average elevation is about 6,150 ft. above sea level with very little change. The timber, which is located in the westerly portion of the township, consists of juniper and pinon, the undergrowth is mainly sagebrush, with some native grasses.</p> <p>No mineral deposits of value were noted.</p> <p>Access to the area is provided by one main dirt road coming from Interstate 80, which is approximately 60 miles north, and continues south to Station Spring, Nevada. Further access is provided by several dirt roads.</p> <p>The mean magnetic declination is 17° E.</p>
