	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area retraced and surveyed is situated approximately four miles north of Ruby Lake National Wildlife Refuge Headquarters. The soil is sandy loam. The average elevation is about 6,150 ft. above sea level, with very little change. There is no timber in the area, the undergrowth consists of sagebrush, buckbrush and scattering patches of native grasses.</p> <p>No mineral deposits of value were noted.</p> <p>Access to the area is provided by one main dirt road coming from Interstate 80, which is approximately 60 miles north and the dirt road continues south to Station Spring, Nevada. Further access is provided by several dirt roads.</p> <p>The mean magnetic declination is 17° E.</p>
