

T. 30 N., R. 58 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada

CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent re-survey of portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines and the subdivision of secs. 24 and 25, Township 30 North, Range 58 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines were surveyed by Hatch and Eaton, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1869, as shown on the official plat of survey approved March 29, 1870. Portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines were dependently resurveyed, and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed, under Group No. 103, by Carl S. Swanholm, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, in 1924-1925, as shown on the official plat of survey accepted February 4, 1929.

The survey was executed in accordance with specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions for Group No. 536, Nevada, dated March 30, 1976.

The directions of all lines were determined by altitude observations on the sun and refer to the true meridian.

Preliminary to the resurvey the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. The retrace-ment data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

The geographic position of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the east boundary of the township, as scaled from the U.S.G.S. 7½ minute series, "FRANKLIN LAKE, NE.", quadrangle map is:

Latitude 40° 26.7' N. Longitude 115° 22.4' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 17° E.
