	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area surveyed and resurveyed is situated about 20 miles east of Elko, Nevada. The average elevation is about 5500 feet above sea level, with very little change throughout the area. No timber exists in the area, the undergrowth is mainly sagebrush, with small amounts of native grass and crested wheat grass.
