	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The area surveyed and resurveyed is situated about 50 miles SSE of Elko, Nevada. The average elevation is about 6,050 ft. above sea level, with very little change throughout the area. There is no timber in the area, the undergrowth consists mainly of sagebrush, with scattering patches of willows and native grasses. Drainage is provided by several small washes, which drain generally in an easterly direction.</p>
	No mineral deposits of value were noted.
	<p>Access to the area is provided by one main dirt road, coming from the NE. and continuing SW. Several small jeep trails provide further access.</p>
	The mean magnetic declination is 17° E.
