CHAINS	<p>At the corner point</p> <p>Reset the iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 4½ ft. base, to top.</p> <p>Deposit the 1917 stone and set a steel fence post alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Cor. is located on the E. edge of a dirt road, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.</p> <p>N. 0° 15' W., bet. secs. 21 and 22, identical with line 1-4 of Homestead Entry Survey No. 195.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through dense sagebrush.</p> <div><div>1.00</div><div>Dirt road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.</div></div> <div><div>2.10</div><div>Telephone lines, 4 strands, bear N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.</div></div> <div><div>19.10</div><div>Barbed wire fence, bears N. 88° W. and S. 88° E.</div></div> <div><div>20.01</div><div><p>Cor.
