	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The land resurveyed in Township 37 North, Range 58 East, ranges from about 5300 to 6800 ft. above sea level and varies from gently rolling in the southeastern portion to rolling in the northwestern portion. The soil consists of sandy clay loam. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grasses.
	Principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of any consequence were noted during the survey.
