40.27	<p>N. 89° 59' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 31.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush; along fence.</p> <p>Point for the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, determined longitudinally at proportionate distance and latitudinally in a fence bearing E. and W., there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SC T36N R59E <u>¼ S 31</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">1976</p>
